


Hey! I am the new ICT teacher and I am teaching throughout the school. I have eight years of experience in web development. I have a master's degree in programming.

Assembly:




Year 6 had their class assembly today and enjoyed explaining and showing what they had been learning. Well done, Year 6 students-you did a great job!
