The School Agreement

The rules and procedures aim to make the school a safe, orderly, and happy working community.

Staff will communicate regularly with parents, keeping them informed about school life, activities, and any concerns. Every effort is made to accommodate individual educational needs.

Based on mutual respect, all children are expected to be polite and sensible; persistent disrespect or aggression will be addressed according to the behaviour policy.

Respect for all is mandatory.

Good work is always rewarded, and progress is systematically recorded.

The school works with the community to develop children's cultural awareness and understanding of a multicultural world.

The Parents' Agreement

As parents, by accepting a place at the English International School of Tunis for our child/ren, we commit to supporting their growth into well-rounded individuals and to actively participating in the school community. Specifically, we agree to:

- _ Ensure our child observes school rules and maintains the expected standard of behaviour.
- _ Ensure our child wears the correct uniform and leaves jewellery, mobile phones, and electronic games at home; all items of clothing will be clearly marked with their name.
- _ Notify the school in writing whenever our child is absent, giving the reason for absence.
- _ Support punctuality (arriving by 7.45 am), regular attendance, and timely collection at the end of the school day (3.30 pm), noting that Daycare is available until 5.00 pm and will be charged automatically.
- _ Support our child in completing homework and any «time-specified» tasks.
- _ Participate, as much as possible, in the social and community activities of the school.
- _ Provide a current emergency contact number and notify the school immediately of any changes.
- _ Make every effort to attend parental meetings and open evenings. Pay all school fees and other necessary charges on time.
- _ Support the school in resolving any issues that arise, working together to find solutions.
- _ Take responsibility for any wilful damage or loss of school property, ensuring it is replaced or repaired.
- _ Commit fully to our child's education at EIST, striving to make it a meaningful and rewarding experience.
- _ Treat all staff with respect, approaching any concerns in a calm and dignified manner.
- _ Agree to communicate reasonably with the school and other parents, refraining from shouting, abuse, threats, or inappropriate engagement with staff, students, or other parents

The Students' Agreement

By accepting a place at the English International School of Tunis, I commit to doing my best to uphold the following:

- Uphold the values of the school at all times.
- Follow school rules as outlined in the Behaviour Policy and accept the consequences if rules are broken.
- Attend school regularly and punctually.
- Bring all necessary equipment required for lessons.
- Wear the school uniform and maintain a neat and tidy appearance.
- Complete classwork and homework to the best of my ability, taking pride in my work.
- Be courteous, polite, and respectful in speech and conduct at all times.
- Behave safely, avoiding actions that may put myself or others at risk.
- Care for the school environment and resources.
- Act as a positive ambassador for the school in all out-of-school situations.

Disciplinary steps regarding unacceptable behaviour

1. A teacher issues up to 2 verbal warnings when a child is choosing to behave unacceptably.
2. If behaviours continue the teacher will isolate the child from the group, then the teacher informs the Head of Section, School Liaison Officer and/Homeroom Teacher officially by email that same day. A behaviour file is started.
3. If 1 and 2 happen again, the School Liaison Officer shall inform the parents officially and receive a verbal warning from the Head of Section. Again, recorded in the file.
4. A child will be put on an 'individual behaviour agreement' via a meeting with the Principal / Head of Section and Parents/Guardians if behaviours continue. The duration of this agreement may vary, but normally it would be monitored for a period of 2 weeks.
5. If the child fails to follow the 'individual behaviour agreement' they will be suspended from school until further notice.

Note : For severe behaviours, such as fighting, the Principal has discretion to suspend the child immediately.

If payment is not received by the school within one week, parents must present themselves to the school cashier.

e. Enrolment and Re-enrolment

Enrolment or re-enrolment of a pupil constitutes acceptance of the fees and the financial regulations of the establishment. The fees paid for re-enrolment or initial enrolment are non-refundable and are definitively retained by the institution should the enrolment be cancelled for any reason.

Parents' explicit and unconditional acceptance of this condition at the time of enrolment or re-enrolment is required. Any request for a refund of pre-enrolment fees will be automatically declined, with no possibility of appeal.

Any payment received is automatically subject to the deduction of bank charges generated by the transfer or POS terminal fees.

In the event of early withdrawal (when a pupil leaves the English International School of Tunis during the school year). Any month that has begun is payable in full.

f. Tuition Fees : The enrollment fees are payable in full.

Prices vary according to the level of education. The enrolment or re-enrolment of a student implies acceptance of the rates and conditions detailed in the institution's financial regulations. There is a single price for schooling at EIST for all registered students, regardless of nationality.

Failure to pay will result in the automatic exclusion of the student, except in special cases submitted to the EIST School Committee. An individual allowance of 10% on tuition fees is granted from the third child enrolled in the establishment, provided that brothers or sisters are also enrolled at EIST.
